Mark: You will see.

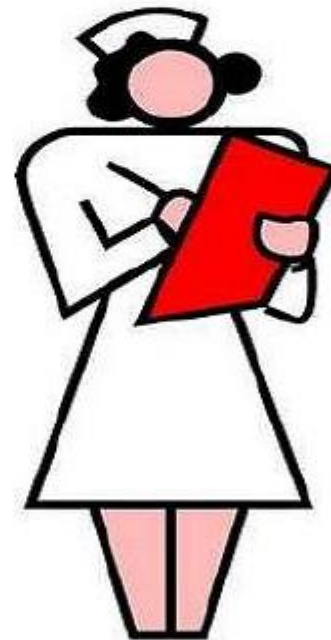
