#### Discussion:

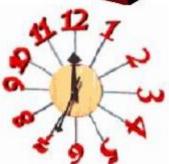

Peter: It is really fine.

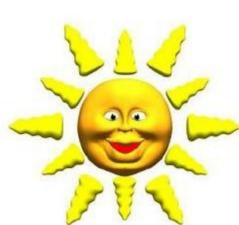
